If active sync is not working or the PDA server is slow it is best to try with "Enable advanced network functionality" disabled (un-ticked). We will further investigate placing an option for this in the admin system.

\*To disable this setting - START > SETTINGS > CONNECTIONS TAB > USB to PC

## **Samsung i600 Error 5 issue**

For Samsung i600 (Blackjack) the device will need to be unlocked prior to installation of SafeBoot Device encryption for Windows Mobile. Contact the Product Manager if you require assistance with this.
